Gloucestershire Academy of Music Residential and non-Residential Holiday courses have been running for over 30 years with students returning year after year.

The Academy's nonresidential courses are held at the Academy's music centre in the centre of Gloucester close to the Historic docks.

With a large hall, recital room and plentiful smaller sectional spaces the centre is the ideal location for music workshops and courses.



Many of the Bow It Students will also go on to take part in the summer Junior Orchestra and Sing It courses.

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Students need to bring their own instrument, spare strings and a pencil (ideally 2B) each day.

Students also need to bring a packed lunch each day and they have full use of the hall and space to play outside during recreation periods, supervised by our team of Welfare Staff.

All tuition costs are included in the course fee and a drink and snack are provided at break time
